EXAMPLE ITINERARY

DAY 1

*Arrival at Ngama *Time of arrival will depend on transport arrangements.
Welcome and Check-in at the lodge, lunch will be provided for early arrivals.
After settling in and enjoying the afternoon at the lodge, a delicious dinner will be served.
After dinner the Night Drive departs, this allows the opportunity to search for the more elusive nocturnal creatures that live on our reserve.*

DAY 2

*An early wake up today to depart at dawn for a full Day Kruger National Park Safari. Spend the day exploring the beautiful diversity the park has to offer. Coffee and tea breaks and a hearty brunch will be provided.
Return to the lodge in the late afternoon and relax before dinner is served.*

DAY 3

*A day spent at the lodge. This is time to rest and enjoy the surroundings of the lodge.
A private picnic is set up for breakfast or lunch, and a relaxing massage treatment is arranged during the day.
To end off the day, dinner is served.*

DAY 4

Wake up to the dawn chorus and head off on a guided bush walk before returning to the lodge for breakfast.

Lunch will be served before departing for an afternoon game drive in Manyeleti Game Reserve. Your guide will be looking for the big 5 along with all the amazing creatures that you have a chance to see. The drive finishes as dusk sets in and the return to the lodge in time for dinner.

DAY 5

After enjoying breakfast at the lodge, it is time to travel up the escarpment to experience a tour of the panorama route, epitomized by the majestic views of the Blyde River Canyon. There are a variety of interesting places to visit such as Three Rondawels, Bourke's Luck Potholes, God's Window and the Graskop Gorge Lift to name a few. A unique lunch stop over is provided during the tour.

Once returning to the lodge in the late afternoon, it is another opportunity to unwind at the lodge before dinner.

DAY 6

No activities planned for the morning, breakfast will be served before its time to depart from the lodge.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

ACCOMMODATION:

Accommodation provided in Tented Chalets or the Bush House.

MEALS: Breakfast, lunch, dinner, and mineral water included.

EXCLUDES: Drinks, gratuities, laundry, and any other extras not included.

ACTIVITIES: Activities are conducted outdoors and are affected by the weather conditions. Changes may occur due to this and are unfortunately beyond our control.

CHILDREN: We regret no children under 10 years at our tented camp. Children 10-14 years pay rates indicated in rates sheet above.

CONSERVATION FEE: Please note a conservation fee is payable at Guernsey Private Nature Reserve. The rate is a once-off fee of R100.00 for sedans & similar vehicles or R200.00 for minibuses or similar vehicles. This is to be paid in cash upon arrival. This fee is included in all our transfers.

GETTING THERE:

BY ROAD: Various options available to book at additional charges. Please see transfer rates provided.

BY AIR: The nearest airport is Eastgate airport which is located near the town of Hoedspruit and about 40 minutes' drive from Ngama. Other airports from which transfers can be arranged: Johannesburg OR Tambo International Airport, Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport, Skukuza Airport.

ITEMS TO REMEMBER TO BRING:

October–April: Casual summer clothes and a warm clothing for the cooler mornings & evenings.

May–September: Casual light clothing and very warm clothing for the cold mornings and nights.

Cotton clothing in neutral colours is recommended. Keep whites to a minimum as white attracts certain bugs at night.

Comfortable walking shoes for bush walks and sandals to wear around the lodge.

Formal attire is not required.

Swimming costumes/bathing suits
Sun block/sun hat/sunglasses/lip balm. Cameras and binoculars.

WEATHER: Enjoying a subtropical climate with hot summers and mild winters.

Spring (Sep–Nov): 18°C - 30°C

Summer (Dec–Feb): 23°C - 34°C

Autumn (Mar–May): 12°C - 28°C

Winter (June–Aug): 10°C - 24°C

CHECK IN/CHECK OUT TIMES:

Check-in: 13:00 to 17:00

Check-out: By 10h00

ELECTRICITY: All electrical outlets are 220v AC. International adaptors are available at the lodge.

MALARIA: We are based in a low risk malaria area. It is advisable to consult with your medical practitioner regarding any necessary medication or precautions.

PAYMENTS AT LODGE: Accounts may be settled at the lodge with Cash (South African Rands) or Credit Cards (Visa and Mastercard only) upon departure.

TARRIFF CHANGES: All rates are subject to change. Rates are quoted in South African Rands and are inclusive of 15% VAT.

PROVISIONAL RESERVATIONS: All provisional reservations will be released if not confirmed within 7 days of booking being made.

PAYMENT: 20% non-refundable deposit is required to secure the booking.

Full pre-payment will be required 30 days prior to arrival.

Ngama Tented Safari Lodge only accepts valid Visa and MasterCard. We unfortunately do not accept Diners, Amex or Debit cards.

CANCELLATION POLICY: 100% cancellation fee will apply to all cancellations received 30 days or less prior to arrival.
